

Chairman Ritchie asked Assistant Town Administrator, Christiane Farrell if this Committee needs to do anything else once the Isle of Palms is approved to come into the automatic aid agreement.

Ms. Farrell stated that she believes they will simply be added and does not necessarily believe it will require action.

Chairman Ritchie stated that he knows that the Town has one of the best medical response teams and asked if there are more requests for paramedic aid.

Chief Mixon stated that they have not. He said this was initially not included in the agreement and are just responding to fire-type calls. He said that they have advised Isle of Palms and some others that if EMS is delayed and it is a critical situation and the Town's assistance is needed, they are happy to respond. He said on the data sheet presented, none of the calls are for medical and have not been requested as a mutual aid agreement item. He stated that if they are covering a station downtown Charleston and a medical call comes in, they will respond.
