

Town Hall, Mt. Pleasant, C., June 4, 1900

Regular. A Regular Meeting of Town Council was held this evening at 8.30

Present - R. O. Royall, Intendant, and Wardens Hamlin, Mitchell, Smith and Finckea.

The Minutes of the last Regular and the Special Meeting were read and confirmed.

Reports. The Report from the Intendants Court stated that \$27.⁰⁰ in fines had been collected; and the Marshal reported the collection of \$12.²⁵ in Licenses.

The Committee on the selection of a New Cemetery site reported their inability to secure one. The Committee was continued with instructions to prosecute the search.

Warden Smith's Notice of Bill relating to the Ferry Landing was continued at his request.

3rd Reading. The Bill to Prevent the Unnecessary Discharge of Fire-Arms passed to its Third Reading. On Warden Finckea's motion it was passed as a whole, its title changed to that of an Ordinance, and ordered properly engrossed, signed and sealed.

3rd Reading. The Bill to Provide the Office of Cemetery Keeper was taken up for Third Reading. On Warden Hamlin's motion it was passed as a whole, its title changed to that of an Ordinance, and properly engrossed, signed, and sealed.

3rd Reading. The Bill to Prevent the destruction of Insectivorous and Song Birds was called up for Third Reading. On Warden Finckea's motion it ^{was} passed as a whole, its title changed to that of an Ordinance, and ordered properly engrossed, signed and sealed.

The Bill to Drain Private Lots was, on Warden Finckea's motion deferred to the next meeting.

Notice. Warden Smith gave notice of the introduction at the next meeting of the Supply Bill for the ensuing year.

On motion of Warden Hamlin the name of Mitchell Lane was given to the alley between the properties of E. L. Hall, Jr., and Mrs. B. Clements running from Hibben to Mary Streets.

Warden Finckea's Bill on stopping trolley cars at all street crossings received its First and Second Reading.
