

Regular.

Town Hall, Mt. Pleasant, S.C., Aug. 20, 1900.
A Regular Meeting of Town Council was held this evening at 8.30.

Present - R.V. Royall, Intendant, and Wardens Coleman, Hamlin, Smith and Pincken.

The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and confirmed.

Reports.

The Intendant's Court reported the collection of \$40⁰⁰.

Result of Election.

The result of the Municipal Election was then declared, namely R.V. Royall Intendant, and Wardens Coleman, Hamlin, ^{Mitchell} Jorgenson, Smith and Pincken. Being all present, they were duly sworn into office to serve for the ensuing two years.

Standing Com.

The Intendant named the old Standing Committees to serve until their duties shall have been defined by Ordinance, substituting the name of Mr. Jorgenson for that of Mr. Winheimer wherever it occurs.

Notice.

Ward Hamlin gave notice of the introduction, at the next Meeting of Council, of an Ordinance to name the Standing Committees of Council and to define their duties.

3rd Reading.

Warden Winheimer's Bill to amend the Chimney Sweeping Ordinance was taken up for Third Reading, and on Warden Smith's motion passed as a whole, its title changed to that of an Ordinance, and was ordered properly engrossed, signed and sealed.

Notice.

Warden Pincken gave notice of the introduction of a Bill authorizing Council to pay the Intendant a fixed salary.

On Warden Pincken's motion Council ordered that ten (10) barrels of crude petroleum be bought for the purpose of experimenting on streets and sidewalks.
