A Regular Meeting of Town Council was held this evening at 7.30

Present:— R. V. Royall, Intendant, and Wardens Coleman, Hamlin, Jorgensen, Smith, and Fincken.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Petition.

A Petition from Sam Steiny asking for an increase of Salary as Assistant Marshal, was read. As more time is now required of him, on motion of Warden Smith the Intendant was allowed \$500 per month more for his services ^{as an assistant Marshal}.

Bills Payable.

Bills of H. B. Hurlbut for \$1.20; C. P. Pankin for \$7.50; W. E. Holmes & Co for \$13.40 were ordered paid.

Continuance.

Warden Fincken asked continuance of his Notice for the Introduction of Ordinances relating to the People's Line of Steamboats.

Electric Lights.

On Warden Fincken's motion a Committee of one was appointed to get all information on Electric Rights for the Town. The Intendant appointed Warden Smith the Committee Chairman. Chairman Smith of the Ways and Means Committee requested that the Treasurer be authorized to borrow money if it becomes necessary to do so. On Warden Jorgensen's motion Council so ordered.
