Town Hall, Mt. Pleasant, S.C., Feb. 14, 1901.
A Regular Meeting of Town Council was held this evening at 7.30.

Present: - R.D. Royall, Intendant, and Wardens Coleman, Hamlin, Jorgensen, Smith, and Fincken.

The Intendant asked for leave of absence on account of important business. ^{during the temporary absence of Warden Hamlin} Warden Smith was asked to the Chair.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Marshal's Report

The Marshal reported the collection of \$2.³⁰ of which some 50 cents were spent by him for various purposes, as per account filed with the Treasurer.

Chimney Contractor

As Chimney Contractor Dix has not attended to his duties, he was, on motion of Warden Jorgensen, dismissed. The Clerk was ordered to notify him of this action.

An application for the office of Chimney Contractor was received from Peter Johnson, and he was unanimously elected.

Bills ordered paid

Bills of E. Fincken for \$23.⁷⁷; W.D. Hamlin for \$8.²⁰ and \$1.⁷⁰ were ordered paid.

Third Reading

Warden Coleman's Bill to Preserve Order in the Intendant's Court received Third Reading. On Motion of Warden Fincken it was passed as a whole, its title changed to that of an Ordinance, and ordered properly engrossed, signed, and sealed.
