Minutes

The Minutes of the last Regular and of the Special Meeting held Feb. 22nd, were read and confirmed.

Ed of Assessors

The Intendant stated that he had been informed by Mr. J. C. Freeman that no report had been made by the County Board of Assessors of the new buildings and improvements made in the town since the last Assessment. On motion of Warden Mitchell, duly seconded, a Committee of two members of Council was appointed to give the information if called upon. The Intendant appointed Wardens Mitchell and Hamlin as said Committee.

Cemetery

Warden Jorgensen moved that a Committee of two with the Intendant be appointed to apportion the Cemetery between the white and colored people. It was so ordered, and the Intendant appointed Wardens Jorgensen and Hamlin on that Committee.

Wt. of Pythias

Warden Jorgensen moved that, recognizing the enterprise of the Knights of Pythias, a charitable society, in building a fine Hall in a prominent part of the town, the license collected from the Contractor be donated to the Lodge of the Knights of Pythias. So ordered.
