A Special meeting of Town Council was held  
this evening at 8 o'clock.

Present: — R. V. Royal, Intendant, and Warden  
Hauken, Jorgensen and Mitchell.

The Intendant stated that this meeting had been  
called to give the Bell Telephone Bill its First and  
Second Reading.

The Bill granting permission to the Bell Telephone  
Co. to erect poles on the Streets of the Town for the use  
of their wires received its First Reading.

given to pass the Bill to Second Reading. The Bill was read the  
second time.
