Town Hall, ^{Monk Pleasant S.C.} Council held this
 At special meeting of Council held this
 1st day of October 1907. There were present
 Intendant R. V. Royall with Wardens W. E.
 Freeman W. E. Arms H. W. Branch and E.
 Fincken.

Intendant R. V. Royall stated that
 the meeting was called for the purpose of
 considering several propositions in the interest
 of obtaining Water Works in the Town.

The following Motion of Warden Arms
 was unanimously adopted, that an advisory
 committee of at least four citizens of the
 Town be appointed, by the Intendant, and
 with the Intendant to recommend some
 feasible plans by which Water Works can
 be put up in the Town.

Mess J. H. DuPre, E. O'Hall Jr, J. C.
 Jorgensen and S. T. Donaldson were appointed
 on said committee.

On motion of Warden Fincken
 the Intendant was authorized to sign
 contract with J. B. McCrary & Co of
 Atlanta Ga for making preliminary
 plans and specifications for Water
 Works, the price being \$150.00.

There being no further business
 meeting was adjourned
