

Council Chamber May 13<sup>th</sup> 1948.

A special meeting of Town Council was held at 8 P.M. this evening, with the following members present: Mayor F. F. Coleman, Councilmen G. P. Darby, H. J. Taylor Jr., John E. Rayall, Paul J. Foster and John C. Schweicy. Mr. Harold Tatum, Architect for Library Bldg. Project was also present.

Mr. Tatum reported that he had authorized the Contractor G. M. Canady Co. to treat the soil, under the concrete floor, for protection against termites, at an added cost of \$136.00. On motion of Councilman Darby, seconded by Councilman Foster, the action of the Architect was approved.

The bids for heating the Library Bldg were as follows:

After a general discussion of the above bids, and upon recommendation of the Architect, Mr. Tatum, on motion by Councilman Foster, seconded by Councilman Darby, the bid of the Domestic Gas Co. Inc. as set out in their proposal, for a cost of \$307.95, be accepted and that the Domestic Gas Co. Inc. be authorized to proceed with installation. This motion was unanimously carried.
