Regular Meeting of Town Council, Present Hon W.A King Mayor, Alderman Donaldson Kelly King Cassard and Tiencken Alderman Douch Absent

Minutes of last meeting held Feb 15 were read and approved. A letter from Mr James Sotille was read in reference to making up a paid Fire Department by enlisting the paid town employees. Alderman Kelly moved that the Sotille letter be forwarded to Mess Pinckney & Pinckney for information as to the requirements of a paid Fire Department see and carried.

A letter from Thos. R. Hamlin in reference to the condition of tidal drain under Boundary Street and condition of ditch leading from Boundary St to Pitt St was read. Alderman Kelly moved that the letter be referred to Committee on Drains with power to act. See and carried

On motion of Alderman Tiencken note for \$200 of King Bros and a note for \$100. W.A King, be renewed to July 24, and a note for \$1000. to Exchange Bank & Trust Co be renewed to July 30. see & carried
