Mount Pleasant S.C. Dec 9. 1915

Special Meeting of Town Council held for the purpose of discussing improvements to be made to streets by use of Sanitary & Drainage Commission outfit Mr E R Venning Foreman Present Hon W A King Mayor Alderman Kelly Donaldson Sasser and King.

Mr Venning made a statement of the results of his work and cost to be expected - as follows.

6 mules, 4 negroes, 1 road machine & Plow
 Cost Feeding 6 mules 60¢ per day each or not to exceed
 " 4 laborers \$ 3.25 " " " " " "

Mr Venning 3.00 per day and 1.50 for Sundays
 8 hours of labor to constitute a days work

Motion of Alderman Sasser, that Mr Venning's proposition be accepted on basis of his statement see & carried

Alderman Donaldson moved that Mr Venning be employed four weeks or more see & carried

Alderman Sasser moved that Mr Venning begin work near the Bridge on Hibben St and follow car tracks through to Core Bridge - then through Hibben to Boundary St, Cross Streets are to be finished as far as practicable, see & carried

On motion Council adjourned.
