

Council Chamber

Mount Pleasant S.C. April 3 1916

Regular meeting of Council, Present Hon. W.A. King Mayor, Aldermen Kelly, Donaldson, King & Tiencken.

Minutes of last meeting were read and approved.
Treasurer reported receipt of Dispensary check for December quarter 344.06, and dispensary ck for 137.62 for educational purposes.

Mr. H. Baker requested Council to place a concrete sidewalk in front of his residence on King Street. Motion of Alderman Tiencken that Mr. Baker request be referred to the Street Committee secretary.
Council discussed different kinds of roofing for the Council Chamber - Alderman Tiencken offered to obtain prices on all kinds of roofing laid, and submit prices to Council, which was agreed to.

Alderman King gave notice that he will at next meeting of Council introduce a new supply bill for 1916-17.

Alderman King called attention of Council to the condition of the approach to driveway leading to Ferry Wharf.

The Clerk was requested to write the Charleston S of P. Traction Co of the complaint.

The Mayor entered a complaint of the entrance from Hebbin to Church St, the curves in the car tracks at this point makes it difficult to enter Church St without injury to vehicle tires, and suggested that the curved tracks be planked over.

The Clerk was ordered to write the Charleston S of P. Traction Co of the complaint.
