

Mount Pleasant S.C.

Council Chamber July 3rd 1916

Regular meeting of Council Present Hon. H. A. King, Mayor, and Aldermen King, Donaldson, Kelly, Fincken, and Sassard.

Minutes of last two meetings were read and approved. Chas. North appeared before Council representing parties that desire to obtain some authority to require the people interested in Ocean Grove Cemetery to keep the grounds in order and supervise burials.

Motion of Alderman Fincken that a committee of two be appointed to receive report of Cemetery Committee, consider same, and report at next meeting of Council. seconded and carried.

Mayor appointed Messrs Fincken and Donaldson. Mayor King reported that the Pennsylvania Society had written Council, making a proposition for the purchase of the jail lot. Mayor appointed Alderman L. L. King, E. Fincken, + S. T. Donaldson a committee to confer with the Society by letter or otherwise on the subject.

Alderman Fincken moved that the Treasurer be authorized to pay himself the fee due for issuing executions in 1915; seconded and carried.

After some discussion of the resolution passed, relative to the proposed sidewalk between rail road tracks and property of Mr. C. C. Hall, it was decided that Mr. King should call on Mr. Hall and try to settle the matter of the proposed sidewalk.

Alderman Fincken moved that the Treasurer be authorized to make penalty on payments due the town after July 15th to August 15th 2% instead of 15% as formerly.

On motion Council adjourned.
