Meeting of Council appointed for Thursday, Aug 31<sup>st</sup>.  
 Present His Honor, W. A. King Mayor, Alderman  
 Fincken, Sassard, King, and Donaldson.

Minutes of last meeting were read and approved.  
 Motion was made by Alderman Fincken that the  
 Treasurer be authorized to receive all payments  
 for taxes up to and including Aug 31<sup>st</sup> with  
 a penalty not to exceed two percent, seconded  
 and carried.

The Clerk was instructed to "swear in" the new  
 Mayor on Tuesday Sept 5<sup>th</sup> at 8<sup>30</sup>, as Monday  
 was Labor Day.
