

Council Chamber, Monday Evening Dec. 4, 1922.

Regular meeting of Council held this evening.

Petition of A. W. C. Chung or motion of C. A. Weinheimer and seconded by H. A. Wacker was referred to committee on streets, and to report at next meeting of Council.

On motion of H. R. Hale, and seconded by W. L. Erickman, the Mayor was authorized to appoint a committee of two members of Council to confer with a committee of Boy Scout masters in regards to allowing them the use of part of Alhambra grounds to be used as a Boy Scout camp for a period of five years. The Mayor appointed W. L. Wacker and W. L. Erickman.

The Mayor appointed a bridging permit committee consisting of, C. A. Weinheimer, Chairman, J. E. Coleman, H. R. Hale.

The chairman on streets reported the Bennett street sidewalk work satisfactorily done, at a cost of \$18.00 for the labor, plus cost of material. Motion by W. L. Erickman, and duly seconded and adopted, that the Mayor employ a surveyor and have the street at the head of Town wharf on Cherry Creek surveyed.
