

Council Chamber Monday Evening November 3rd 1924

Regular meeting of Council held this evening

Present Mayor M. Simmons

Aldermen Coleman, Erickson, Weinheimer,
Freeman, Finnegan and Donaldson.

Minutes of regular meeting of October 7th were
read and approved.

The treasurer's report showing a balance of
\$625.84 was received as information.
