

Council Chamber Monday evening Sept. 14<sup>th</sup> 1925

Regular meeting of Council held this evening

Present Mayor G. Simmons

Aldermen Freeman, Coleman, Donaldson,  
Eckman and Weinheimer.

Mayor Simmons granted Alderman Freeman's  
request, to be excused, on account of sickness at  
his home.

approved.

\$2636.46 was received as information

and put up and that the cleaning of the  
streets was progressing satisfactorily.

Mr A. A. Everett by the unanimous vote  
of Council was made town surveyor.

Alderman Donaldson moved that the Clerk  
be authorized to purchase a table and cover  
for the town's typewriter desk. Seconded and  
unanimously adopted.

Council unanimously authorized the giving  
of \$1.00 per week to George Stacker, a blind  
pauper.
