

Council Chamber May 10-1932

A meeting of Council was held this evening  
 Present were P. G. McCauley Mayor  
 Councilmen, Erickson, Coleman, Armas Freeman, Frederick Simmons  
 Mr. McCauley stated that the meeting was called  
 to hear and act on request of Capt. Baitley to change  
 the landing terminal of the Fort Sumter Navigation Tours, Inc.  
 from its present terminal to the Stern Creek landing.  
 Mr. Crossland attorney for Capt. Baitley read the request  
 for the change, and made quite a lengthy talk on the why  
 and wherefor, and the benefit to the Citizens of McPleasant  
 of the change.

The Council then went into executive session.  
 Mr. McCauley called for a vote, whether to allow Capt. Baitley  
 to move to Stern Creek or not.

The Council voted unanimously, refusing the request  
 of Capt. Baitley.

The Clerk was instructed to notify Capt. Baitley,  
 that what ever piling was necessary to be put under the  
 wharf at once, and particular the south west corner of  
 wharf under the shed, and also to put shed in proper  
 repair, and the roof repaired, and plankings  
 all repairs to be done immediately.

 Council adjourned.
