

TRANSCRIPT OF MINUTES.

Regular meeting of Town Council of Town of Mount Pleasant, Charleston County, S. C., was held this evening, May 21st, 1934, at 8 o'clock P. M. pursuant to due notice, given in writing to each member of Council in form as follows:

"Dear Sir:

Please attend a very important meeting of Council, Monday evening, May 21st at 8 o'clock relative to the Water Works.

There were present W. L. Erckmann, J. E. Coleman, R. M. Hale and W. E. Tiencken, constituting a quorum, and G. M. Darby, Clerk.

T. G. McCants the former Intendant having died the 28th day of March, 1934, W. L. Erckmann presided, having been elected by Council as Intendant Pro Tem, at meeting held November 7th, 1932, the following being the extract of minutes of meeting held that day:

"Nomination of W. L. Erckmann, as Mayor Pro Tem, offered by Mr. Yonge Simmons, seconded by Mr. R. M. Hale, - unanimously elected."

The Intendant read a letter to Mr. George F. Von Kolnitz from the Chief Counsel of the P. W. A. transmitting proposed Loan Contract with U. S. Government and stated that it should be considered and if satisfactory approved. The proposed contract was read and discussed and Mr. J. E. Coleman offered the following Ordinance, the adoption of which, the same having been seconded by Mr. R. M. Hale, was unanimously voted.

"AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ENTERING OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT PLEASANT, CHARLESTON COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING A LOAN."

After passage the Ordinance was ratified.
