The Mayor explained to Council the situation of the property bid on at the Sheriff sale last November and asked for the sentiments of Council as to the disposition. After the matter had consideration a motion was made by Mr. Hesson that the property be forfeited, the motion was seconded and made unanimous by Council.

The Mayor also called the attention of Council to the expenses incurred by Mr. Von Kolwitz, the Town attorney, and suggested that Mr. Von Kolwitz be reimbursed for these voluntary expenditures. Mr. Hesson moved that these be returned to Mr. Von Kolwitz, but that gentleman being present refused to accept the refund.
