

COUNCIL CHAMBER MONDAY APRIL 6TH 1936

Meeting of Council was held this evening with Mayor Edmann, and Aldermen Darby, Fiencken, Penning and Weston present.

Minutes of meetings of March second and March sixth read and confirmed.

The following bills were read and ordered paid.
