A special meeting of Council was held this evening with the following members present - Mayor W. L. Eickmann, Aldermen Weston, Siemken, Smith and Darby.

Mr. J. B. Burch, a representative of the American Service Co. appeared before Council and presented a proposition from his company to furnish curtains and scenery for the stage at Alhambra Hall at a cost of \$35.00 to be paid for by advertisements to be solicited by a representative of his company. He ~~is~~ ^{is} to guarantee 10% of the above amount in the event that sufficient funds cannot be raised by sale of advertisements.

A motion was made by Mr. Weston and seconded by Mr. Siemken that the proposition of Mr. ^{Burch} be submitted to Council in writing and if found acceptable to enter into the contract with his company provided the total cost to the Town would not be in excess of \$3.50 and that all checks in payment of advertisements be made payable to the Town Treas.

Mr. Burch prepared a contract incorporating the above provisions which was signed by the Mayor and Clerk.
