Regular Meeting of Town Council was held this evening with the following members present - Mayor W. L. Eckman Aldermen - Weston - Smith - Sampson - Melchers - Darby & Jencken

Mayor Eckman advised Council that the P. J. A had requested that the Xmas tree lights be loaned them for use at their Halloween Party - Council unanimously granted the request.

Mr. Pearce reported to Council that Mr. Geo. F. von Kolwitz representing Mrs. W. P. Jencken had advised him that he was trying to secure an I. H. A team to repair the property of Mrs. Jencken which had been condemned by the Town and that work would be commenced as soon as funds were available -

Mr. Pearce also reported that Mrs. Kricher had advised him that she had authorized Mr. Upsee, her agent, to make the necessary repairs to her property. In regard to the Weinkamer property, Mr. Pearce advised Council that the owners were willing to tear down the building if necessary and that it was being occupied by parties from whom no revenue was received as a matter of charity. Mr. Pearce was requested to ask the Weinkamers to complete or tear down the other building on the property.

Mr. Pearce advised Council that Mr. Shanker of the firm of Nathans and Shankley had agreed that his firm would act as bond Council for the Town in connection with the proposed issue of \$67,500 refunding waterworks revenue bonds for a fee of \$375.00 - Clerk was instructed to write Nathans & Shankley retaining them as bond Council and advising them that a fee of \$375.00 was acceptable.
