A Special Meeting of Town Council was held this evening with the following Members present - Mayor W. L. Eckmann Aldermen - Weston, Smith, Melchers, Hampton Parby and Hencken -

Mayor Eckman advised Council that the meeting had been called at the request of Alderman Melchers to consider the advisability of quarantining visitors to the Town during the duration of the infantile Paralysis epidemic. After a discussion, Council decided that this matter came under the jurisdiction of the County Health Board.

The question of the location of the proposed road from Charleston to Sullivan's Island was discussed by Council. Council decided to circulate a petition among the residents of the Town requesting the State Highway Department to locate the Highway on Whilden and Cummer St. It was also decided to get up a delegation of Council men and residents to call on the State Highway Engineers and present the above request.

There being no further business Council was adjourned.
