

Council Chamber Monday April 20 1942.

a Special Meeting of Town Council was held this evening with the following members present. Mayor W. H. Erickmann, Aldermen, Melchers, Smith, Thompson, Royall and Tiencken -

Mayor Erickmann advised Council that the meeting had been called to hear a protest from Mr Clark in regard to the location of the Sewer pumping station in Perry Street.

Alderman Smith stated that after making a personal inspection of the location he believed that Council voted and passed at their last meeting, the motion in regard to the location of the Sewer pumping station, on a misunderstanding and made a motion which was seconded by Alderman Tiencken and passed unanimously that the motion passed at the last meeting be revoked and the Engineer notified and that the Engineer be instructed to locate the pumping station nearer Pitt St.

On motion of Alderman Tiencken Council was adjourned.
