

Council Chamber Monday March 29 1943

A special meeting of Town Council was held this evening with the following members present. Mayor W. L. Erickman Alderman Weston, Smith, Sieneken and Freeman.

Mayor Erickman read to Council a petition requesting that a fire Hydrant be placed near the corner of Queen and Pitt streets to provide protection to buildings in this section. On motion of Alderman Weston seconded by Alderman Freeman Council instructed the Clerk to write a letter to the Waterworks Commission and request that a Hydrant be installed at the corner of Pitt and Queen Streets.

Alderman Weston reported to Council a complaint he had received from Mrs. Thayer F. Webb, in regard to the collection of garbage from her home.

The Mayor was requested to advise Mrs. Webb that no exception could be made to the rules in regard to the collection of garbage.

Alderman Weston advised Council that due to labor conditions the Town Marshall was forced to drive the Town Truck, and that he felt that the Marshall was entitled to an increase in salary. On motion of Alderman Smith seconded by Alderman Freeman, Council voted to increase the Marshall Salary to 200.00 per month as of March 15 1943. and for such time as

Alderman Smith advised Council that the Lutheran Church wanted permission to construct a pavement in front of the Church on Pitt St. On motion of Alderman Weston seconded by Alderman Freeman, Council voted to grant permission provided it met with the approval of the State Highway Dept.

There being no further business Council was adjourned.
