

Council Chamber Wednesday Aug 7 1946-

A Special Meeting of Town Council was held this evening with the following members present. Mayor Erickmann Aldermen - Weston, Frampton, Melchers Freeman and Dienckew.

On Motion of Ald. Weston seconded by Ald Frampton, Council voted to receive a legal opinion in regard to election laws from the Town Atty.

~~After~~ Mr. Pearce advised Council that all primary election laws had been repealed and the primary elections were now governed by the rules of the Democratic Party.

Mr. Pearce further advised Council that the coming Municipal election was a general election and would have to be held in accordance with the laws in regard to general elections. and that the general election laws did not provide for a single ballot containing the names of all candidates.

On Motion of Ald Weston seconded by Ald Freeman Council voted that the election be governed by the rules of the Democratic Club and the laws of South Carolina.

Council was adjourned on Motion of Ald Diencken.
