

Council Chamber Friday Dec 20 1946-

A special meeting of Town Council was held this evening with the following members present Mayor Coleman, Aldermen Foster, Taylor, Schwesers Royall and Weston.

The Mayor advised Council that the meeting had been called to consider application for appointment to the position of temporary Town Marshall.

On motion of Ald Weston seconded by Ald. Foster, Council voted unanimously to accept the application of M. H. Gentry for appointment to the position of temporary Town Marshall commencing immediately.

The Clerk was instructed to write letters to the applicants thanking them and advising that after due consideration M. H. Gentry was appointed.

Council requested the Mayor to invite all parties interested in the Shen Creek Bridge matter to be present at the Town Hall meeting of the U.S. <sup>District</sup> Engineer.

On motion of Ald Schwesers seconded by Ald Taylor, Council authorized the Mayor to negotiate with the Charleston County Development Board to have a wharf or wharves constructed in Shen Creek on property of the Town.

There being no further business, Council was adjourned.
